

Footprint vs. biodiversity

Ecological footprint and biodiversity are two concepts that are often mentioned together, but they are not the same. The ecological footprint is a measure of the demand on the Earth's ecosystems by human activities. It is calculated by adding up the area of land and water required to produce the goods and services consumed by a population, and the area of land and water required to absorb the waste generated by that population. Biodiversity, on the other hand, is a measure of the variety of life in a particular ecosystem. It is calculated by counting the number of different species of plants, animals, and microorganisms that live in that ecosystem.

FOOTPRINT VS. BIODIVERSITY

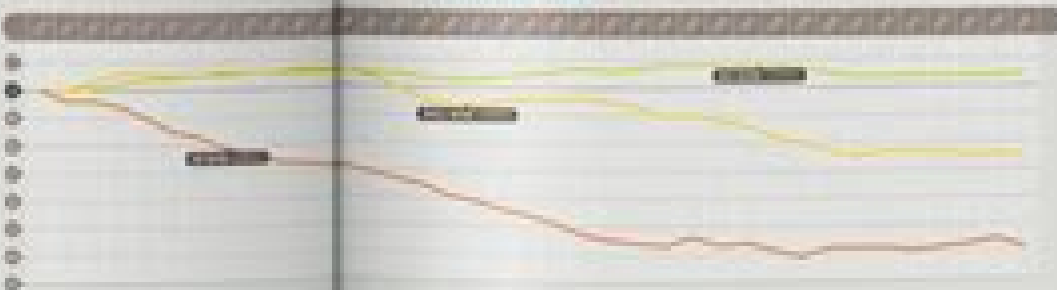

GLOBAL ENVIRONMENTAL TRENDS

The Living Planet Index (LPI) is a measure of the health of the world's ecosystems. It is calculated by tracking the population trends of 14,000 vertebrate species across 13,000 populations in 140 countries. The LPI shows that the world's ecosystems are in a state of decline, with the average population of the tracked species falling by 68% since 1970. This decline is most pronounced in freshwater ecosystems, where the average population has fallen by 82%. The LPI also shows that the decline is occurring across all regions of the world, with the most significant declines in Asia and Europe. The LPI is a powerful tool for monitoring the health of the world's ecosystems and for identifying the causes of the decline. It is also a key indicator for the Sustainable Development Goals, which call for the protection and restoration of ecosystems.
