Taste (qustatory)

Tass for bourds:

- sensory structures that detect taste.
- located on papillae on tongue, hard palate, throat
- Inside each taste bud are 40 taste cells
- Each taste cell has taste hairs that extend into taste pores

Papillae - Contains taste bud

Formes

- fillform most numerous papillae on the surface of the tongue but have no taste buds.
 - Provide a rough surface on the tongue, allowing it to manipulate food more easily.
- valiate largest but least numerous of the papillae.
- foliate distributed in folds on the sides of the tongue and contain the most sensitive of the taste buds.
- fungiform- scattered irregularly over the entire superior surface of the tongue

Histology

3 major types of specialized epithelial cells:

- sensory cells each taste bud w/ 50 taste cells, or gustatory cells.
- basal cells precursor cells that differentiate into mature taste cells.
- Supporting cells play a role in the clearance of excess neurotransmitters after their release from taste receptor cells.
- Like olfactory cells, taste cells are exposed and are replaced continuously.
- normal lifespan of a taste cell 10 days.

Taste Process:

- Taste buds pick up taste and send it to taste cells.
- 2. Taste cells send taste to taste hairs.
- Taste hairs contain receptors that initiate an action potential which is carried to the parietal lobe.
- Elrain processes taste.

Neuronal Pathways for Taste

- Facial nerve (VII): the chorda tympani transmits taste sensations from the anterior two-thirds of the tongue, except from the valiate papillae.
- Gloss-opharyngeal nerve (D): carries taste sensations from the posterior one-third of the tongue, the vallate papillae, and the superior pharyns.

Vagus nerve (X): carries a few fibers for taste sensation from the epiglottis.

Taste - linked to smell.

Vision - Includes the eyes, the accessory structures, and the optic nerves (II), tracts, and pathways

The Eye and Access on Structures

- Eyebrow protects from sweat, shade from the sun
- Eyelid lubricates by blinking.
 - Palpebral fissure space between 2 eyelids
 - Canthi angles where eyelids join at the medial & lateral margins of the eye
 - Caruncle small, reddish-pink mound in medial canthus housing some modified sebaceous & sweat glands

Ewellid Layers:

- Skin
- Areolar connective tissue
- Skeletal musicle: orbicularis oculi & levator palpebrae superioris musicles
- Dense connective tissue: tarsal plate (helps maintain shape of eyelid)
- Palpebral conjunctiva
- Eyelashes attached as a double or triple row of hairs to the free edges of the eyelids.
- Ciliary glands modified sweat glands that open into the follicles of the eyelashes to keep them lubric ated
- Sty forms when one of these glands becomes inflamed
- Meibomian glands, or tarsal glands are sebaceous glands near the inner margins of the eyelids
- Chatazion meibomian cyst, is an infection or a blockage of a meibomian gland.
- Conjunctiva a thin, transparent mucous membrane associated with the eyelids and the exposed areas of the eye
- palpebral conjunctiva covers the inner surface of the evelids
- bulbar conjunctiva covers the anterior white surface of the eve
