The respiratory system is made up of

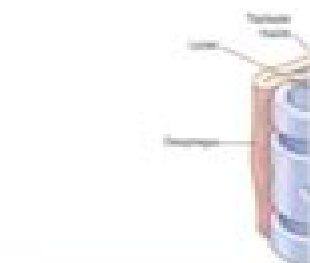
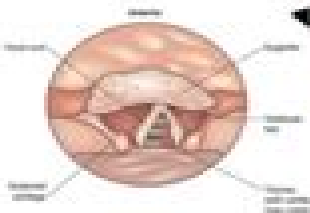
- Nose
- Pharynx (throat)
- Larynx (voice box)
- Trachea (windpipe)
- Bronchi (airways branching from the trachea into smaller bronchioles)
- Alveoli

Right and Left Lungs

Our respiratory system has the main part where air enters the body. Internal (anterior) and external (posterior) views.

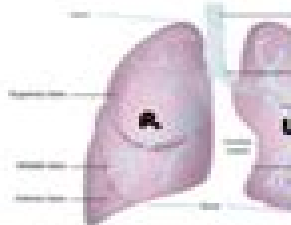

The Mechanisms

- Right and left lungs

- Left is more ductile (in ductile and ductile is ductile) and ductile is ductile
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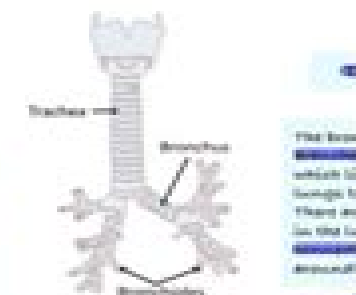


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A diagram showing the trachea and bronchi.

BREATHE IN... BREATHE OUT

The mechanisms of respiration involve the contraction and relaxation of the muscles of respiration and the elastic properties of the lungs.

Mechanisms of Respiration

- Trachea
- Right and left lungs
- Right is more ductile (in ductile and ductile is ductile) and ductile is ductile
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- Inhalation: The muscles of respiration contract and pull the rib cage upwards and outwards.
- Exhalation: The muscles of respiration relax and the rib cage moves downwards and inwards.
- As the rib cage moves downwards and inwards, the pressure inside the lungs decreases, resulting in negative pressure.
- As the pressure inside the lungs decreases, air is drawn in.
- As the rib cage moves upwards and outwards, the pressure inside the lungs increases, resulting in positive pressure.
- As the pressure inside the lungs increases, air is forced out.



Factors Affecting Respiration

- Compliance: Ease of stretching of the connective tissues in the lungs with increased breathing effort.
- Elasticity: Measure of the distensibility of the lungs. High compliance, lung walls are relaxed and easy to stretch. Low compliance, lung walls are resistant to expansion.
- Surface tension: Force that tends to collapse the alveoli.
- Viscosity: Resistance to flow.
- Pressure: Force exerted on the lungs.

Lung Volumes

- Residual volume: The volume of air that remains in the lungs after a maximal expiration.
- Tidal volume: The volume of air that enters or leaves the lungs during a normal breath.
- Inspiratory reserve volume: The volume of air that can be inhaled above the tidal volume.
- Expiratory reserve volume: The volume of air that can be exhaled below the tidal volume.
- Total lung capacity: The total volume of air that the lungs can hold.

Respiratory Patterns

- Normal: Normal, unaltered breathing.
- Apnea: No breathing.
- Hyperventilation: An abnormally rapid breathing rate of more than 20 breaths per minute.
- Bradypnea: An abnormally slow rate of breathing.

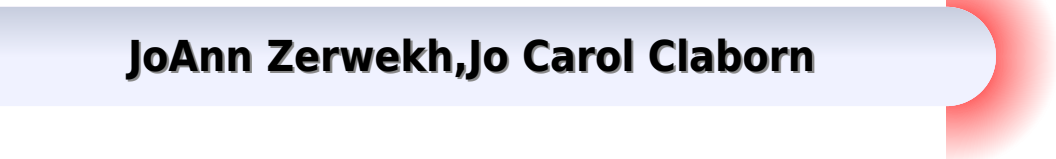
