emulates Dupin were transferred to the beginning of The Adventure of the Resident Patient In some later U S editions of the Memoirs which still omit The Adventure of the Cardboard Box this transfer still appears Doyle had decided that these would be the last collection of Holmes s stories and initially decided to get him killed in The Final Problem However public pressure forced him to write the character again in The Hound of Baskervilles and resurrect him in the forthcoming The Return of Sherlock Holmes
