The plant cell and the animal cell, which are both cukaryotic cells, do contain organelles. Such organization allows eukaryotic cells to function in more-complex ways than prokaryotic cells. A plant cell differs from an animal cell in that the plant cell has a cell wall, a central vacuole, and chloroplasts. All three cells share many characteristics. The cells have a cell membrane, cytoplasm, and genetic material. They all have the ability to reproduce.
