Craig, 2019-05-16 During the sweeping changes taking place in 19th-century Japan, no thinker was more important than Fukuzawa Yukichi (1835-1901). Born into a low-ranking samurai family, he traveled to Nagasaki at age nineteen to study Dutch. In 1858, he was sent to Edo to teach Dutch to domain students. In his spare time, he taught himself English using a Dutch-English dictionary. Two years later, he was appointed a translator of diplomatic documents at the shogunal office of foreign affairs. In 1862, he founded a school that is now Keio University. Eager to introduce Western history and ideas to the Japanese, he wrote a series of books, including the bestselling *Conditions in the West* (1866). In the late 1870s, he turned his attention to the prospects for parliamentary government in Japan. The central government was firmly in place, and elective prefectural

assemblies were about to be established He wrote essays on the workings of such a system drawing on his earlier travels abroad and his reading of de Tocqueville John Stuart Mill Walter Bagehot and others A realist and optimist Fukuzawa assured his readers of the eventual success of parliamentary government in Japan This book provides the first English language translation of five essays that bear directly on the development of his thought and its legacy in Japanese culture

Taylor, 2004-09-08 The previous conference in this series AMTA 2002 took up the theme From Research to Real Users and sought to explore why recent research on data driven machine translation didn t seem to be moving to the marketplace As it turned out the rst commercial products of the data driven research movement were just over the horizon and in the intervening two years they have begun to appear in the marketplace At the same time rule based machine translation systems are introducing data driven techniques into the mix in their products Machine translation as a software application has a 50 year history There are an increasing number of exciting deployments of MT many of which will be exhibited and discussed at the conference But the scale of commercial use has never approached the estimates of the latent demand In light of this we reversed the question from AMTA 2002 to look at the next step in the path to commercial success for MT We took user needs as our theme and explored how or whether market requirements are feeding into research programs The transition of research discoveries to practical use involves technical questions that are not as sexy as those that have driven the research community and research funding Important product issues such as system customizability computing resource requirements and usability and fitness for particular tasks need to engage the creative energies of all parts of our community especially research as we move machine translation from a niche application to a more pervasive language conversion process These topics were addressed at the conference through the papers contained in these proceedings and even more specifically through several invited presentations and panels
