would be primarily Backus words with minor changes to make his language more easily understood Passages without these marks would be the parts that I have added In this book I try to help the reader to distinguish between the Holy Fear of God and the unholy fear of God by the use of capital letters In many ways it would be most helpful to do the Bible study on the Fear of God before actually reading this book as it would help a reader to first become more familiar with the Biblical message of the Fear of God In Brother Backus day the Fear of God was inculcated taught often and with great repetition but in our day this doctrine has sadly been lost I believe that it is time as in Josiah s day to clean out the temple and rediscover ALL that has been lost concerning the Fear of God It is time also for those who Fear the Lord to speak often to one another THEN THOSE WHO FEARED THE LORD SPOKE TO ONE ANOTHER and the LORD gave attention and heard it and a book of remembrance was written before Him for those who fear the LORD and who esteem His name They will be Mine says the LORD of hosts on the day that I prepare My own possession and I will spare them as a man spares his own son who serves him SO YOU WILL AGAIN DISTINGUISH BETWEEN THE RIGHTEOUS AND THE WICKED BETWEEN ONE WHO SERVES GOD AND ONE WHO DOES NOT SERVE HIM Malachi 3 16 18 NASU My prayer is that God would awaken in hearts today a desire to learn all of what His Word teaches about the Fear of God and that we and our Churches would once again inculcate the Fear of God and be truthfully called God Fearing **A treatise concerning the Fear of God: scripturally**
