The False Apocalypse From Stalinism To Capitalism:

False Apocalypse Fatos Lubonja, 2014 This unique and disturbing work concerns the events of 1997 a tragic year in the history of post communist Albania After the world s most isolated country emerged from Stalinist dictatorship and opened to capitalism many people fell prey to fraudsters who invited them to invest in so called pyramid schemes At the start of 1997 these pyramids crumbled one after another causing wide spread demonstrations and protests The conflict became increasingly violent leading to the collapse of the state and of the country s institutions Prisons were opened crowds stormed arms depots and the country was abandoned to anarchy and gang rule Lubonja has chosen to tell this incredible story through a narrative technique that operates on two levels a third person narrator who describes the large scale events that made international headlines and the narrative of Fatos Qorri the author s alter ego who describes his own dramatic experiences in a personal diary The book begins with the synopsis of a novel entitled The Sugar Boat that Fatos Qorri intends to write about the spread of a small pyramid scheme luring people to invest supposedly in a sugar business However as the major pyramids collapse real events overtake anything he has imagined and Fatos Qorri finds himself in the midst of a real life tragedy

To the Lake Kapka Kassabova, 2020-08-04 The celebrated author of *Border* explores a mysterious ancient and little understood corner of Europe Lake Ohrid and Lake Prespa Two ancient lakes joined by underground rivers Two lakes that seem to hold both the turbulent

memories of the region's past and the secret of its enduring allure. Two lakes that have played a central role in Kapka Kassabova's maternal family. As she journeys to her grandmother's place of origin, Kassabova encounters a historic crossroads. The lakes are set within the mountainous borderlands of North Macedonia, Albania, and Greece, and crowned by the old Via Egnatia, which once connected Rome to Constantinople. A former trading and spiritual nexus of the southern Balkans, this lake region remains one of Eurasia's most diverse corners. Meanwhile, with their remote rock churches, changeable currents, and large population of migratory birds, the lakes live in their own time. By exploring, on water and land, the stories of poets, fishermen, and caretakers, misfits, rulers, and inheritors of war and exile, Kassabova uncovers the human destinies shaped by the lakes. Setting out to resolve her own ancestral legacy, Kassabova locates a deeper inquiry into how geography and politics imprint themselves upon families and nations, one that confronts her with universal questions about human suffering and the capacity for change.

Audible States Nicholas Tochka, 2016 During the Cold War, state-sponsored musical performances were central to the diplomatic agendas of the United States and the Soviet Union. In Albania, in particular, the postwar government invested heavily in public performances at home, effectively creating a new genre of popular music: the wildly popular light music.
