Yadon, 2017-04-03 In thirty five chapters The Greatest Air Aces Stories Ever Told covers many of the leading American and British Commonwealth fighter aces of WW I and II together with a few bomber crews whose gallantry made a substantial contribution to the end of WW II Other nations had their aces but this book concentrates on American and Commonwealth pilots These aviators were chosen not only because of their scores and their great courage but also for other qualities which set them apart like the WWII Royal Air Force Wing Commander who shot down more than 20 Germans while flying with two artificial legs Here are a few of the aces Note that the air forces of Europe and the United States did not always have today's names used here for simplicity's sake Albert Ball RAF son of the Lord Mayor of Nottingham winner of the Victoria Cross He had 44 victories in WWI when he was killed at the age of 20 well known to his German foes who much admired him Gabby Gabreski USAF Son of hard working Polish immigrants An ace in WWII with 28 kills and later in Korea with another six He was an accomplished commander finished a long career as a colonel Mick Mannock RAF Tough and aggressive in spite of his fear of fire he won not only the Victoria Cross but five other high awards for gallantry Highest British scorer of WWI with 73 victories he detested Germans and rejoiced with every kill He was shot down by ground fire in the last year of the war David McCampbell USN Scored 34 WWII kills to become the U S Navy's all time ace In 1944 set an all time record with nine victories on a single mission Winner of the Congressional Medal Pick Pickard RAF Led the RAF rooftop bomber raid on Amiens Prison In WWII

freeing many underground members some of whom were facing death and who were promptly spirited away by French partisans

Frank Luke USAF Deadly American famous for his busting of German observation balloons in WWI Shot up over German territory he managed to land safely but being Luke tried to fight it out with enemy infantrymen with only his pistol

The book will also touch on the equipment these aces flew from the famous Fokkers and Sopwith Camels to the ungainly two seater FE2b which was driven by a pusher engine and looked like a bathtub with wings and a miniature oil derrick glued on the back Also included are our own Grumman carrier fighters the P 40s the P 38s as well as the P 51 Mustang probably the finest fighter of the war a happy marriage of an American airframe and a British engine The deadly graceful Spitfire has its place as do the Hurricane the biplane Gladiator and even the four engine Lancaster

Americans are familiar with the day that will live in infamy At 9 30 a m on Sunday December 7 1941 Pearl Harbor the advanced base of the United States Navy's Pacific Fleet was ablaze It had been smashed by aircraft launched by the carriers of the Imperial Japanese Navy All eight battleships had been sunk or badly damaged 350 aircraft had been knocked out and over 2 000 Americans lay dead Indelible images of the USS Arizona exploding and the USS Oklahoma capsizing and floating upside down have been ingrained in the American conscience ever since In less than an hour and a half the Japanese had almost wiped out America's entire naval presence in the Pacific Less than 24 hours earlier Japanese and American negotiators had been continuing their diplomatic efforts to stave off conflict in the region but as they did President Roosevelt and his inner circle had seen intelligence reports strongly suggesting an imminent attack though they did not know where The U S rightly believed that Japan would take action to prevent the Americans from interfering with their military activities in Southeast Asia and American military forces in the Philippines were already bracing for a potential attack However as the negotiations were ongoing the powerful Japanese carrier fleet had been surging southwards through the Pacific while maintaining radio silence preparing to strike the blow that would ignite war in an area spanning half the globe Navy Commander in Chief Isoroku Yamamoto whose code of honor demanded that the Japanese only engage enemies after a formal declaration of war had been given assurances that his nation would be formally at war with the United States prior to the arrival of his planes over Pearl Harbor As it turned out those assurances were worth nothing and Yamamoto had been misled by extremists in his government just as the Americans were misled In fact the Japanese would infamously deliver

documents formally cutting off negotiations with the American government after the attack on Pearl Harbor had already been conducted. Far from a formal declaration of war, America was attacked without warning, plunging the world's largest democracy into history's deadliest conflict. Pearl Harbor was unquestionably one of the seminal events in American history, and given the nature of the surprise attack, the entry of the U.S. into the war, and the lingering controversies and conspiracy theories, the attack on Pearl Harbor continues to be a highly charged and heavily debated event. Those who had decoded and seen the Japanese communications in early December 1941 would not be surprised when they heard about an attack on December 7, 1941. They would, however, be astonished when they heard where that attack took place. Posted on the other side of the world, it was early on the morning of December 8, in the Philippines, when American general Douglas MacArthur received news of the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor hours earlier. With that, it could only be a matter of time before the Japanese attacked the Philippines. Although MacArthur and Allied forces tried to hold out, they could only fight a delaying action, and the Japanese managed to subdue all resistance by the spring of 1942. However, in the aftermath of Japan's successful invasion, as the nation's military strategists began preparations for the next phase of military actions in the theater, their forces had to deal with a critical logistical problem they had not foreseen. The Japanese had to deal with large numbers of Filipino and American soldiers who had surrendered after a lengthy defense in the Bataan peninsula, but they were not prepared for so many prisoners of war because their own military philosophy emphasized rigid discipline and fighting until the end.

Born to wealth, adventuresome in spirit, shrewd in business, gallant in war, and a beau idéal of his class, Tommy Hitchcock was the epitome of the American hero, a legend even in his own time. To Scott Fitzgerald, Tommy embodied the ideal of the aristocratic man of action, basing two of his characters loosely on Tommy. Tommy joined the Lafayette Escadrille during WWI at the age of 17. He was shot down, captured by the Germans, and then made a dramatic escape to Switzerland. Within a few years after the war, he had become one of the stars of the Golden Age of Sport. In the 20s and 30s

Tommy dominated polo more decisively than Bobby Jones did golf or Babe Ruth did baseball. Settling in New York with his growing family, he became an investment banker and threw famous parties in Great Neck, Long Island, which attracted the rich and famous as well as celebrities such as Scott and Zelda Fitzgerald. Always impecunious, the Fitzgeralds were easy to attract to a lavish party but not so easy to convince to leave. When America entered WWII, Tommy re-entered the service but was told he was too old for combat flying. He became the biggest booster of the new P-51 then in development, becoming instrumental in convincing the Army to build it to protect Flying Fortresses on their bombing raids over Germany. We were losing hundreds of the heavy bombers to Luftwaffe Messerschmitts because we didn't have a fighter that could reach Germany with the bombers. The P-51 was a game changer. Hermann Goering, commander of the Luftwaffe, told his American interrogators after the war that when he saw P-51s flying unopposed in the skies over Berlin, he knew the jig was up and Germany would lose the war. Tragically, on April 18, 1944, Tommy died test flying one of the new P-51s in England.
