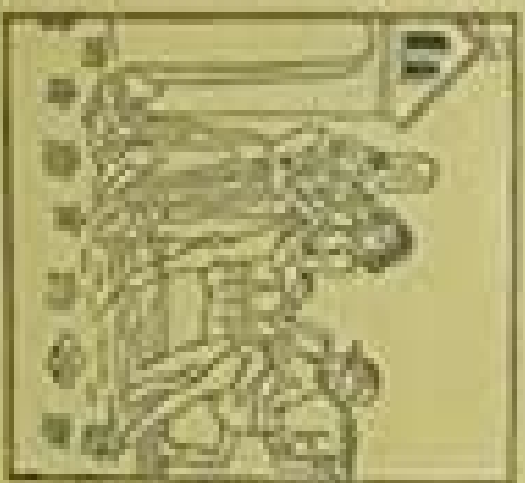


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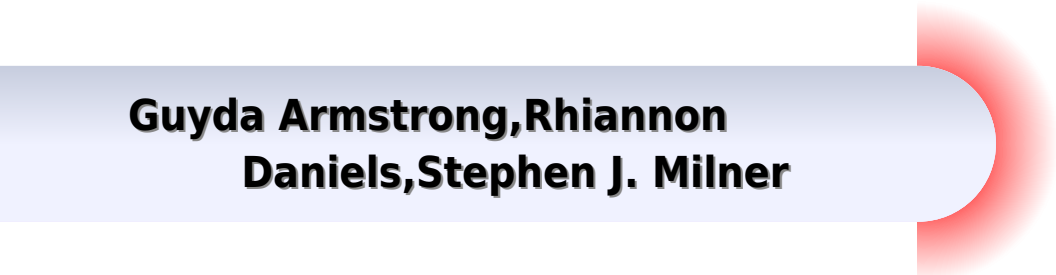

Instead, Gittes shows that Boccaccio deliberately assumed this posture of passivity to align himself with a series of martyrs who like him had willingly suffered torments in the interest of cultural advancement. A concern for cleanliness, he argues, was everywhere in the Renaissance.
