Angolite ,2003 **Instrument of the State** Benjamin J. Harbert,2023 Louisiana State Penitentiary is one of the largest and most brutal maximum security prisons in the United States Built on the grounds of a former plantation the prison is commonly referred to as Angola apropos of the country of origin for many of the enslaved people who inhabited the land Despite notoriously inhumane conditions within the prison people incarcerated at Angola have sustained a rich and dynamic musical legacy since the late nineteenth century attracting folklorists such as John and Alan Lomax and Harry Oster Well known musicians including Huddie William Lead Belly Ledbetter Charles Neville and James Booker played a part in this history in addition to a litany of others who proved vital to the prison s musical culture but for various reasons were unable to establish their careers upon release In *Instrument of the State* author Benjamin J Harbert interweaves oral history and archival research to show how incarcerated musicians find small but essential freedoms by performing jazz R B country gospel rock and fusion throughout the Twentieth Century In doing so he expands folkloric definitions of prison music considering the ways in which music manifests among the incarcerated and the prison s administration as a lens to better understand state power and the fragments of hope and joy that remain in its wake *Instrument of the State* acts as an indictment of the carceral state highlighting the many ways in which the US penal system disproportionately affects African American people through desperate profiteering of a deliberately underfunded state agency **Prison Theatre and the Global Crisis of Incarceration** Ashley E. Hobbs illuminates how policy makers enlarged Louisiana's carceral infrastructures with new prisons and jail expansions alongside the bulking up of police and prosecutorial power. At the same time these infrastructures were the products of multiscalar crises: the swings of global oil capitalism, liberal federal court and policy interventions, the rise of neoliberal governance and law and order austerity and racist and patriarchal moral panics surrounding crime. However, these crises have also created fertile space for anticarceral social movements. From incarcerated people filing conditions of confinement lawsuits and Angola activists challenging life without parole to grassroots organizers struggling to shrink the New Orleans jail following Hurricane Katrina and LGBTQ youth of color organizing against police sexual violence, grassroots movements stretch us toward new geographies of freedom in the lineage of abolition democracy. Understanding Louisiana's carceral crisis extends our understanding of the interplay between the crises of mass criminalization and racial capitalism while highlighting the conditions of possibility for dismantling carceral power in all its forms.

The Angola Prison Seminary Michael Hallett, Joshua Hays, Byron R. Johnson, Sung Joon Jang, Grant Duwe, 2016-08-05. Corrections officials faced with rising populations and shrinking budgets have increasingly welcomed faith-based providers offering services at no cost to help meet the needs of inmates. Drawing from three years of on-site research, this book utilizes survey analysis along with life history interviews of inmates and staff to explore the history, purpose, and functioning of the Inmate Minister program at Louisiana State Penitentiary, aka Angola, America's largest maximum security prison. This book takes seriously attributions from inmates that faith is helpful for surviving prison and explores the implications of religious programming for an American corrections system in crisis featuring high recidivism, dehumanizing violence, and often draconian punishments. A first of its kind prototype in a quickly expanding policy arena, Angola's unique Inmate Minister program deploys trained graduates of the New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary in bi-vocational pastoral service roles throughout the prison. Inmates lead their own congregations and serve in lay ministry capacities in hospice, cell block visitation, delivery of familial death notifications to fellow inmates, sidewalk counseling, and tier ministry, officiating inmate funerals and delivering care packages to indigent prisoners. Life history interviews uncover deep level change in self-identity corresponding with a growing body of research on identity change and religiously motivated desistance. The concluding chapter addresses concerns regarding the First Amendment, the dysfunctional state of U.S. corrections, and directions for future research.
