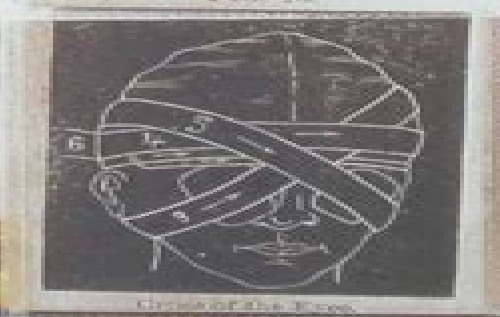
Wooden Case of the Skull
