world The book's subtitle putting the term child language into the plural points out that not one but many written interpretations of the child's perspectives are possible In order to emphasize this plurality and indicate that there are any number of child languages the author has organized his study as a series of closely related essays Each chapter considers the work of a Canadian author or authors with the book as a whole moving from the more conventional writers to those who step outside the bounds of convention Ricou proposes analogies with Wordsworth and Dylan Thomas Proust and Dickens but he finds his principal subject in the inherent interest of for example the Piagetian scheme that W O Mitchell seems to adopt in *Who Has Seen the Wind* the obsessions with similes in Ernest Buckler the variations on the Bildungsroman in Margaret Laurence and Alice Munro and the persistent experiments with presymbolic language in Bill Bissett For these and other writers such as Clark Blaise Emily Carr Dennis Lee Dorothy Livesay P K Page James Reaney and Miriam Waddington Ricou illuminates the particular literary languages appropriate to each author's subject The result is a fascinating and unique approach to Canadian literature
