- > Evolution - explains how species change and adapt. > There are +2 million different species. > Darwin Wrote: The Origin of Species.
- > In Argentina, Darwin discovered several fossils, which were mammals.
- > He traveled to the Galapagos Islands and found marine iguanas, tortoises, birds, etc.
 - Darwin noticed each tortoise shell was different depending on which island the tortoise was living on. He noticed the same with the finches on each island.
 - After this, Darwin then came up with the theory of *every* species changing over time.
- > In snake embryos, 4 bumps appear as if the limbs of this animal are forming, but they don't actually develop when they hatch.
- > Whales have teeth in embryos, but not when they are born.
- > Darwin got the idea of Natural Selection by looking at the way humans breed dogs.
- > **Natural Selection** - those who survived the extreme situations are most adapted.
- > **Variation** - each offspring are never actually the same.
- > **Evolution of Natural Selection** - how many new species are formed.
- > A volcano that erupted in Arizona now has mice with dark fur due to the darker floor caused by the lava. This place used to be light with mice with lighter colored fur.
- > The codes of DNA make up our genes.
- > Mutation happens when letters in our DNA switch around.
