supported with state resources that can improve access to food for the most marginalized groups

**Extractive Industry Indigenisation in Zimbabwe** Kennedy Manduna, 2025-09-25 This book explains how and why Zimbabwe's extractive industry Indigenisation over promised its benefits yet under delivered upon implementation This book traces the history of uneven development in Zimbabwe from the initial days of colonialism to the present using the extractive industry as the unit of analysis to carve out a granular and empirical analysis of the preponderance of transnational corporate control and ownership in the country Indigenisation of Zimbabwe's extractive industries was intended to address mining inequalities by transferring wealth from rich non Indigenous mining capital to disadvantaged Indigenous citizens and communities This policy however was a response to political economic and social crises posed by the international isolation of Zimbabwe's government following the
