White Men The Complexion of Race asks how such categories would have been possible when and how such statements came to seem illogical and how our understanding of the eighteenth century has been distorted by the imposition of nineteenth and twentieth century notions of race on an earlier period Wheeler traces the emergence of skin color as a predominant marker of identity in British thought and juxtaposes the Enlightenment's scientific speculation on the biology of race with accounts in travel literature fiction and other documents that remain grounded in different models of human variety As a consequence of a burgeoning empire in the second half of the eighteenth century English writers were increasingly preoccupied with differentiating the British nation from its imperial outposts by naming traits that set off the rulers from the ruled although race was one of these traits it was by no means the distinguishing one In the fiction of the time non European characters could still be redeemed by baptism or conversion and the British nation could embrace its mixed race progeny In Wheeler's eighteenth century we see the coexistence of two systems of racialization and to detect a moment when an older order based on the division between Christian and heathen gives way to a new one based on the assertion of difference between black and white

Black Litigants in the Antebellum American South Kimberly M. Welch, 2018-01-02 In the antebellum Natchez district in the heart of slave country black people sued white people in all white courtrooms They sued to enforce the terms of their contracts recover unpaid debts recuperate back wages and claim damages for assault They sued in conflicts over property and personal status And they often won Based on new research conducted in courthouse basements and storage sheds in rural Mississippi and Louisiana Kimberly Welch draws on over 1 000 examples of free and enslaved black litigants who used the courts to protect their interests and reconfigure their place in a tense society To understand their success Welch argues that we must understand the language that they used the language of property in particular to make their claims recognizable and persuasive to others and to link their status as owner to the ideal of a free autonomous citizen In telling their stories Welch reveals a previously unknown world of black legal activity one that is consequential for understanding the long history of race rights and civic inclusion in America

demand that people of African descent be given equal rights and protection under the law In the second part of the book *The Response* Henderson goes on to show that more recent representations of the conditions of slavery by authors such as Williams and Morrison extend the efforts of their predecessors by developing creative responses to those calls centered around the African American body and its scars Henderson explores Williams's reinvention of the whip scarred body in her novel *Dessa Rose* and provides a close analysis of Morrison's use of scar imagery in *Beloved* She also devotes a chapter to Petry's *The Street* and concludes with an investigation of the wounded black male psyche in the works of Ralph Ellison and Richard Wright *Scarring the Black Body* demonstrates that the creative acts of these authors bind together that which has been wounded both literally and figuratively Those who hear the voices of the ancestors are urged to connect to that part of themselves wherein wounds of the past carry a self knowledge that can alter the experiences of the present In this way the disfigured body as a cultural metaphor and social invention can come to terms with its own humanity and embodiment

Activating the Past Andrew Apter, Lauren Derby, 2009-12-14 *Activating the Past* explores critical historical events and transformations associated with embodied memories in the Black Atlantic world The assembled case studies disclose hidden historical references to local and regional encounters with Atlantic modernity focusing on religious festivals that represent political and economic relationships in fetishized forms of power and value Although memories of the slave trade are rarely acknowledged in West Africa and the Americas they have retreated so to speak within ritual associations as restricted repressed even secret histories that are activated during public festivals and through different styles of spirit possession In West Africa our focus on selected port cities along the coast extends into the hinterlands where slave raiding occurred but is poorly documented and rarely acknowledged In the Caribbean regional contrasts between coastal and hinterland communities relate figures of the *j baro* the *indio* and the *caboclo* to their ritual representations in *Santer* a Vodou and *Candomblé* Highlighting the spatial association of memories with shrines and the ritual condensation of regional geographies we locate local spirits and domestic terrains within co extensive Atlantic horizons The volume brings together leading scholars of the African Diaspora who not only explore these ritual archives for significant echoes of the past but also illuminate a subaltern historiography embedded within Atlantic cultural systems
