



FRANKLIN & ARMPFIELD'S SLAVE PRISON.

This establishment is in Alexandria. It is a handsome three story brick house, neatly painted, with green blind's, and the sign, FRANKLIN & ARMFIELD over the door. It has attached to it a large yard, perhaps 300 feet square, enclosed by a high close board fence nearly white-washed, and filled with various small buildings. Mr. Leavitt visited it in 1834. One of the partners lives in New-Orleans, and the other in Alexandria. The latter, says Mr. L. "politely invited us to go and see the Slaves. We were first taken out into a paved yard, 40 or 50 feet square, with a very high brick wall and about half of it covered with a roof. This yard is appropriated to the men. He ordered the men to be called out from the cellar where they sleep, and they soon came up, to the number of 50 or 60, and ranged themselves irregularly before us. While they were standing, he ordered the girls to be called out, when the door opened, and about 50 women and small children came in. They were all clothed decently in coarse but apparently comfortable garments. Some three or four had children, so young that they brought them in their arms; and I thought I saw in the faces of these mothers some indications of irrepressible feeling. It seemed to me that they hugged their little ones more closely, and that a cold perspiration stood on their foreheads, and I thought I saw tears too. There were in all about 38 children under 10 years of age."

"CASH FOR 400 NEGROES."

"Including both sexes, from 12 to 25 years of age. Persons having likely servants to dispose of, will find it to their interest to give us a call, as we will give higher prices in cash than any other purchaser who is now, or may hereafter come into this market."

Slaves for Hire John J. Zaborney, 2012-10-12 In *Slaves for Hire* John J. Zaborney overturns long standing beliefs about slave labor in the antebellum South Previously scholars viewed slave hiring as an aberration a modified form of slavery involving primarily urban male slaves that worked to the laborer's advantage and weakened slavery's institutional integrity In the first in depth examination of slave hiring in Virginia Zaborney suggests that this endemic practice bolstered the institution of slavery in the decades leading up to the Civil War all but assuring Virginia's secession from the Union to protect slavery Moving beyond previous analyses Zaborney examines slave hiring in rural and agricultural settings along with the renting of women children and elderly slaves His research reveals that like non hired out slaves these other workers experiences varied in accordance with sex location occupation economic climate and crop prices as well as owners and renters convictions and financial circumstances Hired slaves in Virginia faced a full range of oppression from nearly full autonomy to harsh exploitation Whites of all economic occupational gender ethnic and age groups including slave owners and non slave owners rented slaves regularly Additionally male owners and hirers often transported slaves to those who worked them and acted as agents for white women who wished to hire out their slaves Ultimately widespread white mastery of hired slaves allowed owners with superfluous slaves to offer them for rent locally rather than selling them to the Lower South establishing the practice as an integral feature of Virginia slavery

The Price They Paid Jeff Forret, 2024-11-19 A prizewinning historian uncovers one of the earliest instances of reparations in America ironically though perhaps not surprisingly paid to slaveholders not former slaves A spectacular achievement of historical research Forret shows for the first time just how far the American government went to secure reparations Robert Elder author of *Calhoun American Heretic* In 1831 the American ship *Comet* carrying 165 enslaved men women and children crashed onto a coral reef near the shore of the Bahamas then part of the British Empire Shortly afterward the Vice Admiralty Court in Nassau

over the outraged objections of the ship's owners set the rescued captives free American slave owners and the companies who insured the liberated human cargo would spend years lobbying for reparations from Great Britain not for the emancipated slaves of course but for the masters deprived of their human property In a work of profoundly relevant research and storytelling historian and Frederick Douglass Prize winner Jeff Forret uncovers how the Comet incident as well as similar episodes that unfolded over the next decade resulted in the British Crown making reparations payments to a U S government that strenuously represented slaveholder interests Through a story that has never been fully explored *The Price They Paid* shows how unlike their former owners and insurers neither the survivors of the Comet and other vessels nor their descendants have ever received reparations for the price they paid in their lives labor and suffering during slavery Any accounting of reparations today requires a fuller understanding of how the debts of slavery have been paid and to whom *The Price They Paid* represents a major step forward in that effort
