Social	- Kin-based Society: Rule of each family - Council: Each male head of a family would be part of council - Chief: Most prominent male head of family - No private property, typical gender roles: men (labor, women (chores) - Women did have other positions like merchants and often had higher authority than other post-classical regions - Age-set jobs, formed tight bonds with people
Political	<u>1000 CE: Limit of Bantu Migrations, Started Creating Complex Forms of Governments</u> - Kin-Based Society: Stateless/Segmentary Societies, Early Bantu societies had little to no central government, mostly there was only rule within a family/kinship groups - District: Group of villages <u>Kinship Turns Into Chiefdom:</u> Population problems caused decline of kinship societies - Population increased, became more complex, formed military forces - Districts fell to chiefs, overrode kinship networks, imposed own authority - After 1000 CE: Consolidated lands into small kingdoms <u>Kingdom of Kongo:</u> Basin of Congo River - 1000 CE: Population problems encouraged formation of kinship societies, embracing a few villages each to form a state - 1220 CE: Conflict between states caused larger, regional principalities, could resist political pressure, among these, Kingdom of Kongo was prosperous - Kingdom of Kongo: Trade networks with copper, raffia cloth, nzimbu shells - Government: King and officials who oversaw political/military affairs - 6 Provinces, administered by governors - Subordinate officials administered districts - Chiefs ruled villages - Administrators could replace subordinates at will <u>Kingdom of Ghana and Kingdom of Mali (Principal state of West Africa):</u> 4th, 5th Century CE - More in economic section - Desert raids weakened and brought collapse, Mali became predominant in West Africa - 13th-15th Century: Controlled trades and taxes through West Africa - Mali First Emperor (Sundiata): 1230, included Ghana - Mansa Musa (1312-1337): Built mosques, religious schools - Factions crippled government, Songhay overtook <u>Swahili: City-States, Governed by King</u>
Interaction	<u>1000 CE: Majority of Migrations of Early African Societies Halted</u> - Early Bantu migrations spread agriculture and herding all over Africa - As they continuously established agricultural societies, people that were there prior (Hunter/Gatherer) were displaced and absorbed into the societies - Yams, sorghums, millets became standard diet - Bananas: Malays may have brought when exploring East African Coasts, 300-500 CE - Malays colonized Madagascar, established banana cultivation
