Today, in contrast, Jews are considered white and for today's anti-colonialists Israel's treatment of the Palestinians has become a critical issue. If it can be found on the far Left it still is a much graver danger from those forces on the Right chanting Jews will not replace us in Charlottesville and their ilk.
