Rural Infrastructure from a World Bank Perspective Louis Y. Pouliquen, 1999 Rural infrastructure is critical to both economic and social development Its absence thwarts growth and typically the poor are those hurt the most The purpose of this paper is to serve as a basis for knowledge management on rural infrastructure In the 1970s the primary if not the unique objective of rural infrastructure lending was to get rural infrastructure built However the institutional aspects of how this infrastructure was to be built and later how it would be operated and maintained did not receive much attention Only recently has poverty alleviation through employment creation become an explicit objective of rural infrastructure investments This review tracks the poverty alleviation objective of rural infrastructure projects using three criteria 1 whether poverty was an explicit criterion in the selection of specific sub projects 2 whether poverty was addressed in the pricing of rural infrastructure services and 3 whether poverty was addressed through the creation of employment *World*

Development Report 1994 ,1994 World Development Report 1994 examines the link between infrastructure and development and explores ways in which developing countries can improve both the provision and the quality of infrastructure services In recent decades developing countries have made substantial investments in infrastructure achieving dramatic gains for households and producers by expanding their access to services such as safe water sanitation electric power telecommunications and transport Even more infrastructure investment and expansion are needed in order to extend the reach of services especially to people living in rural areas and to the poor But as this report shows the quantity of investment cannot be the exclusive focus of policy Improving the quality of infrastructure service also is vital Both quantity and quality improvements are essential to modernize and diversify production help countries compete internationally and accommodate rapid urbanization The report identifies the basic cause of poor past performance as inadequate institutional incentives for improving the provision of infrastructure To promote more efficient and responsive service delivery incentives need to be changed through commercial management competition and user involvement Several trends are helping to improve the performance of infrastructure First innovation in technology and in the regulatory management of markets makes more diversity possible in the supply of services Second an evaluation of the role of government is leading to a shift from direct government provision of services to increasing private sector provision and recent experience in many countries with public private partnerships is highlighting new ways to increase efficiency and expand services Third increased concern about social and environmental sustainability has heightened public interest in infrastructure design and performance **Urban**
