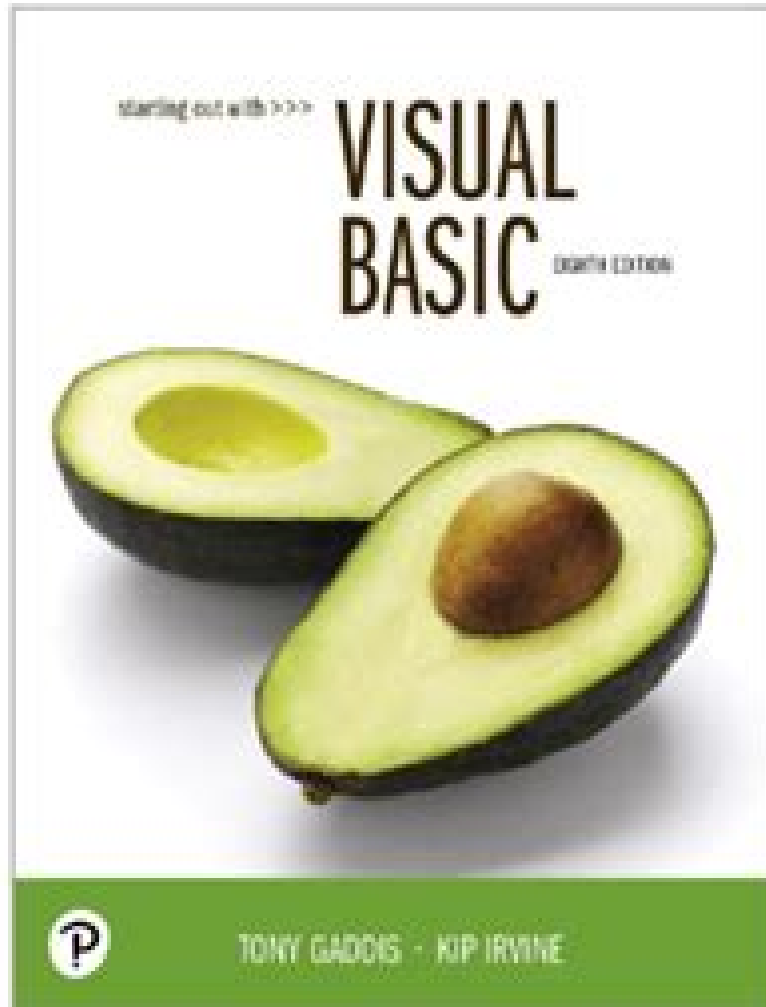

This book is for NET developers who are interested in extending Visual Studio as their development tool. In order to understand the book you must know the following material well: Object oriented programming OOP, the .NET Framework and .NET programming C# or Visual Basic languages, some familiarity with C#, some familiarity with XML and its related topics, and Visual Studio structure and usage.
