

Personal Essay



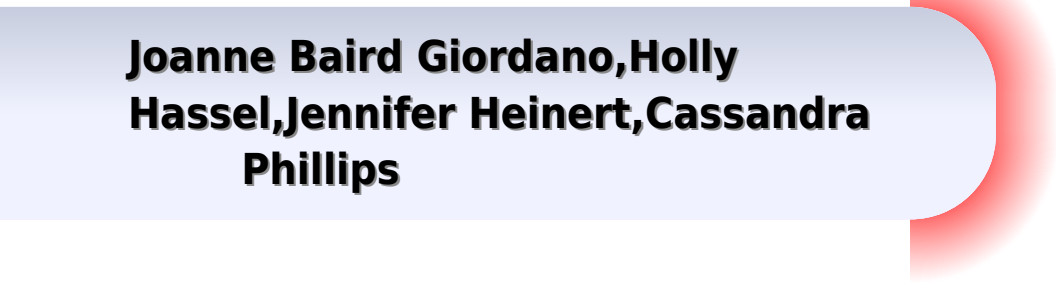
