in that figure, what types of progeny would you expect to see and in what proportions?

Answer: You would get a 1:1 ratio of purple to white. This is because the first-generation he plant has one copy of the purple allele and one copy of the white allele, and as a result, 50 percent gametes would carry the purple allele and 50 percent of the gametes would carry the white a The white-flowered parental variety has two copies of the white allele, and all the gametes prossfrom the white plant will carry the white allele. Hence, a cross between the two would produce ratio of purple to white.

Answer: This depends on the sample size. When the sample size was large, the proportions close to 3:1 (e.g., for round and wrinkled seeds the ratio was 2.95:1 and the total population
