

- Wound or ulcer location
 - Odour? constantly pervading the patient room or only when the wound is uncovered, pre-&/or post cleansing, impact on patient
 - Ulcer etiology and category? stage (for pressure injuries) or classification (for diabetic ulcers), and depth description (partial-thickness or full thickness)
 - Necrotic tissue? is it debriding by autolysis or intact? (see Colour below for description)
 - Drainage? color, consistency, and amount (scant, moderate, large, copious)

- Pain and suffering? when pain occurs, what relieves it, patient's description of pain (stinging, burning, throbbing etc.) and rating on a scale of 0 to 10, impact on daily life
 - Induration or Edema? surrounding tissue hard, soft or edematous
 - Colour of the wound bed? red, yellow, black, or a combination and ESTIMATE relative amounts of different tissue types (% of total)
 - Tunneling or sinus tract? length and direction; use clock-face to describe location, with head being 12 and feet being 6.
 - Undermining? length and direction; use clock-face to describe location, is there redness or other discoloration in skin over the undermined area?
 - Edge of skin? loose or tightly rolled/ edges flat or rolled under, re-epithelializing
 - Size? measure Length x Width (Surface area) and Depth; calculate progress towards healing over time
