| Commenting | <code>"Example comment"</code> | Any commented code is ignored and will not run. You should use comments to annotate and explain your code. |
| Variables | <code>Dim Var As String Var = "Test Data" Var = Console.ReadLine()</code> | Always declare your variables first. Creating them at the top of your program is a good idea. |
| IF THEN Statement | <code>If Var = "Continue" Then "Code Here" End If</code> | Remember the IF statement has to be TRUE in order for the code to run. |
| IF THEN ELSE | <code>If Var = "Continue" Then "Code if true" Else "Code if false" End If</code> | You can control what happens if the statement is TRUE or FALSE. |
| IF THEN ELSE IF | <code>If Var = "Continue" Then "Code if true" ElseIf Var = "Repeat" Then "Code if true" Else "If neither above are true do this" End If</code> | In a situation where there is more than one possibility use an ELSE IF statement. The final ELSE is what happens if all above are true. Remember that this must come last in the statement. |
| Calculations | <code>answer = number1 * number2</code> | Don't forget to DIM your variables first. + - * (x) and / (/). Remember BODMAS. |
| For Loop | <code>For i As Integer = 0 To 10 "Code to repeat here" Next</code> | Remember by default that i will increment by 1 each time. You can use i inside the For Loop code if needed. |
| While Loop | <code>While counter < 1000 "Do code here" End While</code> | Like an IF statement, the While loop will run whilst the statement is TRUE, in this case the variable counter is less than 1000. |
| Do While | <code>Do "Code here" Loop While answer < "42"</code> | The loop condition is tested at the end of the statement, so the loop will run at least once. This can be useful for things like validation. |
| Array (of specific size) | <code>Dim cars(5) As String Cars(0) = "Ford"</code> | This array has 6 elements (remember to index from 0-5). Element 0 has been assigned "Ford". |
| Array (no size at time of Dim) | <code>Dim cars As String()</code> | This is useful if you are going to assign it an array of unknown size later, e.g. using .Split |
| List | <code>Dim cities As New List(Of String) cities.Add("London")</code> | Lists are useful as you don't need to assign a size to them, and they will grow as you need them too. |
| Input | <code>answer = Console.ReadLine()</code> | This will allow the user to enter text from the Console. |
| Output | <code>Console.WriteLine("You chose " & answer)</code> | Remember to add strings / variables together use the & symbol. |
| String Formatting (ToUpper, ToLower, ToUpper) | <code>answer = Console.ReadLine().ToUpper() answer = answer.ToLower()</code> | Forces the input to Upper Case. Replaces answer with a lower case version. Note string formatting can be done at any point needed. |
| Converting data types | <code>Dim answer As String Answer = Console.ReadLine() Dim number As Decimal number = Integer.Parse(answer)</code> | You might need to convert from type to type (e.g. string to int, int to decimal and so on). This is the correct way to do it and you should avoid simply passing the variable (number = answer) is bad practice. |
| Checking Upper, Lower or Symbol | <code>Dim letter As Char letter = "a" Dim isUpper As Boolean isUpper = Char.IsUpper(letter)</code> | There are a range of checks you can do - Upper, Lower, Symbol, Number and so on (see what you can find). |
