What is climate change?

Climate change happens when long-term changes in temperatures and weather patterns occur. Such changes can be natural, due to changes in the sun's activity or large volcanic eruptions. But since the 1800s (the start of the Industrial Revolution), **human activities have been the main cause of climate change**, mostly due to the burning of fossil fuels like coal, oil and gas. https://www.nasa.gov/education/climate/climate_basics.html

Four major causes of climate change are:

- burning fossil fuels
- cutting down forests/trees (deforestation)
- increasing livestock (animals) farming
- fertilizers containing nitrogen

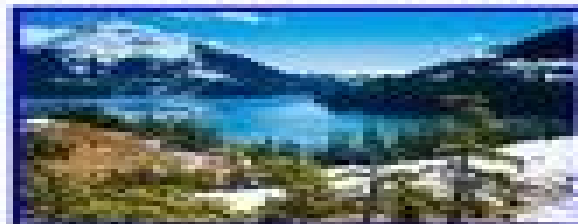
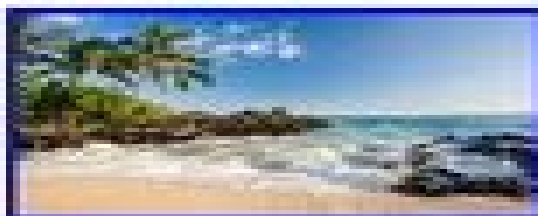
What is the difference between weather and climate?

Weather is what conditions of the atmosphere are over a short period of time, and climate is how the atmosphere "behaves" over relatively long periods of time. https://www.nasa.gov/education/climate/climate_basics.html

For example, in Hawaii it is usually warm and sunny. That is the **climate** of Hawaii and it has been the climate of Hawaii for many decades (10 years) and centuries (100 years).

However, some days it rains, other days are cooler, and occasionally there are hurricanes. This is the **weather** for Hawaii. It may change from day to day or month to month.

The **climate** of Alaska is very different from Hawaii's even though there will also be changing **weather** from day-to-day and month-to-month in Alaska.
