Early Computers

In 1930, Vannevar Bush created *The Differential Analyzer*. It is one of the first modern computers. It could solve difficult problems for physics and engineering that usually took a long time to calculate. However, it could only solve one kind of equation.

The Invention of the Personal Computer

For a long time, computers were used by scientists and businesses only. Even the inexpensive models could cost several hundred thousand dollars. Eventually smaller versions were created for scientists to buy for personal use, but they were still too complicated for the general public. As computers got smaller, hobbyists began to take interest. One company began selling kits to assemble your own computer. Later, a company called Apple, started by two young hobbyists, began to sell directly to the general public. In 1982, a
