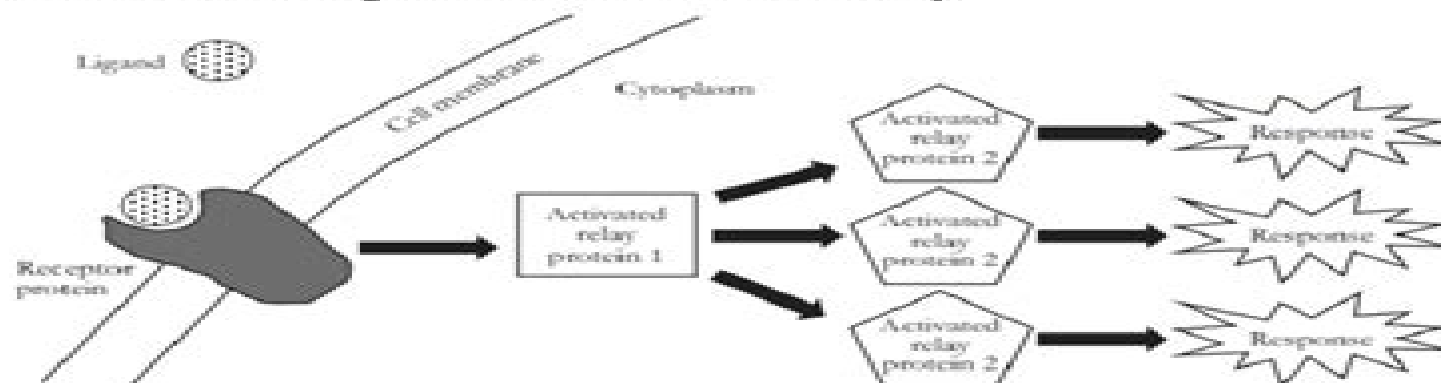
What happens inside of a cell when a signal has been received?

The ultimate goal is a response—a gene is turned on, a protein is manufactured, an enzyme is activated, the cell divides or dies, etc. There are many responses that could occur, but the pathways to those responses are very similar.
