INTERACTIONS with HORMONES

RECEPTORS

- 1) Synergistic: one hormone reinforcing another. Ex: Prolactin + prolactin
- 2) Permissive: one hormone requires another. Ex: thyroxine + progesterone
- 3) Antagonistic: one hormone opposing effect of other. Ex: glucagon + insulin

Lipid-soluble hormone interaction
- bind to intracellular receptors
- hormone receptor complex

water-soluble hormone interaction
- receptors on cell surface to bind
- activates series of intracellular events
- results in cell plasma membrane

ADRENAL

- 1) Trans-mit: (example: junc. in eye)
- 2) Affect immediate: (ex: stress, anger, nervous)
- 3) Response time: quick
- 4) Range of effect: small
- 5) Duration of response: fast (ex: jump start)

ENDOCRINE

- 1) Trans-mit: blood
- 2) Affect: slightly cells on the same target
- 3) Response time: slow (ex: stress, nervous)
- 4) Range of effect: all over
- 5) Duration of response: long (ex: stress, nervous)

NEURAL

- increase of hormone in response to neural stimulation

STIMULATION of hormones

Endocrine

- release of hormone in response to another hormone (release: chain reaction)

HUMORAL

- change in local environment that causes release of hormone

ex: TSH causes release of TH

PROTEIN

- ex: PTH
- water-soluble
