When the author discussed these steps with civilians they frequently respond in all innocence by saying Don t we already have this These three steps are so common sense so obviously needed that the assumption by people who have not investigated this issue is that it has already been taken care of by the powers that be Surely they know this But there is no they We must be the they that voices this obvious need and advocates for its fulfillment. It is a tall order but it must be done
