chapter begins with an overview of international literature to give the conceptual context of the case studies each chapter explores In Chapter 3 the concept of small town tourism branding is illustrated by an exploration of the Richmond book town In Chapter 4 the branding theme is probed further in an investigation of two winners of the Kw la Town of the Year competition namely Fouriesburg and De Rust Chapter 5 documents the branding of Sedgefield through its proclamation as Africa s first Cittaslow slow town a process driven by the local power elite to the exclusion of town s poor who have no understanding of the intentions of the Cittaslow movement and its potential benefits for the town Chapter 6 is a case study of Greyton s tourism led rural gentrification by which a small town has transformed in three decades to become a sought after place of residence for elite inmigrants so making the town a jewel tourism destination while reinforcing racial segregation Because festivals and events creations of the wealthy have made significant financial contributions to small towns Chapter 7 considers festivals and events as strategies to market and brand small towns in a particular way Case studies of the economic impacts of festivals on small towns are assessed and the assessment methodologies used are critiqued Chapter 8 provides a synthesis by drawing on the thesis of the urban growth machine by power elites
