One of the main features of this time was gunpowder forming the basis for Gunpowder Empires which were mainly found in Southwest Asia, Central Asia, and South Asia gunpowder states were just small states that relied on gunpowder and firearms to expand territory and control current territory.

They used gunpowder to keep control over people.

How Europe developed

By the mid 1400s the black plague was nearing off the 100 years war came to an end and the invention of the Gutenberg printing press which made the production of literature much less time consuming as a result increasing Europe's population new monarchies began to arise beginning to centralize power they did this by having control over taxation military, and religion as a result of this power the bureaucracy expanded which is a group of government officials that take the will of whoever is in power some names of monarchs include the Tudors in England, Valois in France, and Isabella and Ferdinand in Spain one side consequence of this concentration was the of powers that the middle class began to grow.

How Russia Developed

Russian territory allowed it to get wealthy on trade Ivan the 4th was crowned in 1547 and became known later as Ivan the Terrible Ivan was able to expand Russian territory further east than by the Mongols which he did with the use of gunpowder Many in Russia converted to Eastern Orthodox Christianity Ivan confiscated land of Boyars (nobles) and tried to control them he also instituted a secret police to keep the power Ivan was called Ivan the Terrible because he did more than previous leaders and was viewed as an over reigning and tyrannical power because he expanded their territory so greatly. He also killed his son.

Peter The Great balanced the interests of the church, boyars, and his powerful family, he forced his half sister out of power putting her in a convent and defended the church he was considered the father of Russian empire as he divided Russia into provinces (guberniya) and sent provincial administrators to make sure they weren't rebellious or corrupt.

How East Asia Developed

The Yuan Dynasty established by the Mongols was overthrown in 1368 which was replaced by the Ming Dynasty which held power in China well into the 1600s however the Mongols were still a huge threat as the Ming dynasty restored the great wall of China around the mid 15th century the Manchus from Manchuria seized power and established the Qing Dynasty in 1644 under the leadership of Emperor Kangxi the Chinese territory expanded into Taiwan, Mongolia, Central Asia, and Tibet which was helped by the use of gunpowder.

How The Islamic Developed

Tamerlane was a Mongol Turkic Leader of Samarkand he was known for his ruthless conquests of India and Persia his power was very stabilized on the military and the amount of money that was needed to support that military was not found as the Empire fell however when they fell the Ottoman Empire The Safavid Empire and the Mughal Empire.

The Ottoman Empire

The Ottoman Empire was one of the largest empires of the Islamic empires during this time established in the 1300s and lasted 600 years in 1453 Turkey under the lead of Mehmet 2 took Constantinople using gunpowder changing the name of that city to Istanbul making them very rich due to the large amount of trade routes connected through Constantinople they stayed under the power of Suleiman The Great who held power from 1520 to 1566 in 1529 he conquered Hungary and a lot of other territories and attempted to push further into Europe but couldn't but did scare the Europeans he used gunpowder to conquer the territory.

Safavid Empire

The leader of the Safavid Empire was Ismail who led them through battle at the age of 14 or 15 years old he made Islam the major religion of the Safavid specifically Shia Islam which united his people while doing this he denied legitimacy to the other branch of Islam the Sunnis which the Ottomans were causing conflict.
