

Chapter 21 Notes:

Long- Distance Trade and Travel:

- The three important reasons for long distance travels were trade, diplomacy, and missionary activity
- As a result of this, cross-cultural interactions helped spread technological innovations throughout the eastern hemisphere

Patterns of Long- Distance Trade:

- Luxury goods such as silk textiles and precious stones, often traveled overland on the Silk Roads used since classical times, while bulkier commodities such as steel, stone, coral, traveled the sea lanes of the Indian Ocean
- The sea lanes of the Indian Ocean served ports in southeast Asia, India, Arabia, and east Africa, while also offering access via the South China Sea to ports in China, Japan, and the spice bearing islands of southeast Asia, making land and sea routes touch almost every corner of the eastern hemisphere

Trading Cities:

- With the increase in trade volume, the major trading cities and ports grew rapidly, therefore attracting buyers, sellers, brokers, and bankers from parts near and far.
- By maintaining strategic locations, maintaining good order, and resisting the temptation to levy excessive custom fees, port cities were able to become emporiums which served long-distance trade networks.
 - Melaka is a good example of this, as it became a clearinghouse of trade in the eastern Indian ocean, as city authorities maintained safe markets, levied reasonable fees, and policed the strategic Strait of Melaka
 - By the end of fifteenth century, Melaka had a population of 50000 people and it was very diverse as many merchants from different places brought their languages.
- The Mongol's campaigns of conquest caused economic disaster in Eurasia, as they toppled Song and Abbasid dynasties, and destroyed cities and irrigation systems
- With consolidation of power over their conquered lands, they laid the political foundation for a surge in long-distance trade along the silk Roads.
- During this time strong economies in China, India, and western Europe fueled demand for foreign commodities as merchants traveled the whole distance from Europe to China in pursuit of profit.
